#### How the program works, "Why you must scan your tag"

Customers that sign up to our program receive a bar coded key tag that "must be scanned at the checkout each time they shop in any of Michaels Supa IGA supermarkets or liquor stores so points can be allocated".

Customers have choose to allocate their points to a community group or collect personal prizes for those points.

Community groups that are nominated by the customers to receive these points will receive 1cent for each point at the end of each financial year. The average shopper spending \$100 per week will as a result of this process earn for their community group approximately \$50 per year and 100 supporters could equate to around \$5000.

The whole program is reliant on customers scanning their Tag and then donating points.
